JULY 24th, 2018 MEETING MINUTES

Club President Zach/K0ZSH brought the meeting to order at 7:00 pm.

- A. Approval of June 2018 Minutes: Motion by Lorne/NOCYK, second by Dewey/KDOBTU, to approve the minutes as published; motion carried.
- B. Treasurer's Report: Dee/KB0CGK presented the Treasurer's report and detailed various expenses since the last meeting. Checking account balance as of July 24, 2018: \$866.35. Savings account balance as of July 24, 2018: \$23,717.15. Motion to approve report by Howard/WB0ATB, second by Dewey/KD0BTU; motion carried.

C. Guests: None

Committee Reports

1. Technical: Mark/NOFAZ gave a presentation on the repairs necessary, parts required, and preferred coax routing for the 85 repeater. The repairs will require hiring a tower maintenance company (probably three technicians for two days). He estimated that the cost would be approximately \$20,000.00 to obtain the parts, hire the tower company, and complete the repairs. Motion by Mike/KE0ESG, second by Dewey/KD0BTU, to extend the amount allocated for repairs to the 85 repeater from \$15,000.00 (as approved at the April 2018 meeting) to \$20,000.00; motion carried.

- 2. Skywarn: Zach/K0ZSH reported that there was one activation since the last meeting, and highlighted the Skywarn activation procedures included in the July 2018
 Noiseletter. He was contacted by the Jamestown ARC for information concerning pagers; Mark/N0FAZ will contact the JARC to provide information.
- 3. VE Testing: Bob/NOTC reported that he has received the new Tech exams and that there will be a new General test next year.

Old Business

- 1. CDARC Picnic: August 28 at 6:00 pm, McDowell Dam recreation area. The grill will be provided by the Aero Club, and beverages will be provided by CDARC. Please bring your own items to cook on the grill; members are also encouraged to bring side dishes. Howard/WBOATB will coordinate a "fox hunt."
- 2. QSL Cards: Jeff/KOCMS presented the new WOZRT QSL card to the group.
- 3. Special Event: Rick/NOMBE and Karen/KCOMBE provided information on the Boy Scouts' 61st "Jamboree on the Air" which will take place Oct 19-21, 2018. Motion by Bob/NOTC, second by Mike/KEOESG that CDARC provide support for this event; motion carried. Dee/KBOCGK will contact the Bismarck Parks & Rec to secure use of the Tom O'Leary golf course warming house for the event. Mark/NOFAZ stated that Bismarck Troop 11 has a call sign (WAOBSA) which may be used for the JOTA.
- 4. Field Day 2018: Howard/WB0ATB gave a report on the CDARC submission to ARRL. 131 contacts were made on all contest bands, 80 meters through 6 meters; contacts were made with 40 states and 4 Canadian provinces. We received 712 field day points this year.

NEW BUSINESS

1. Mail: Zach/K0ZSH received correspondence from Nancy Yoshida/KG0YL, the current North Dakota Section Manager concerning the upcoming section manager election. ARRL also mailed ballots for this election to its ND members. Nancy/KG0YL is running for reelection; David Heintzleman/ND0CW is also running for Section Manager.

2. 50/50 Drawing: \$16 won by Peter/N0ONE; \$15 for the Club (Peter donated the winnings back to the Club).

The meeting adjourned at 7:56 pm.
