Club President Mike/KE0ESG brought the meeting to order at 7:00 pm.

- A. Approval of October 2019 Minutes: Motion by Doc/K0GRM, second by Lorne/N0CYK to approve the minutes; motion carried.
- B. Treasurer's Report: Dee/KB0CGK presented the Treasurer's report, and detailed various expenses since the last meeting. Checking account balance as of November 26th 2019: \$442.82. Savings account balance as of November 26th 2019: \$20,730.60. Motion to approve report made by Bob/NOTC, second by Bruce/WOHS; motion carried.

Committee Reports

- 1. Technical: Randy/KCOCAU reported that there was some kind of interference on the 94 repeater. He reset the repeater and the interference eventually went away.
- 2. Skywarn: Skywarn Recognition Day will be conducted Dec $6^{\rm th}$ at 6:00 pm thru Dec $7^{\rm th}$ 2019, 6:00 pm.
- 3. VE Testing: Nothing to report.

Old Business

1. 85 Repeater Repair: Club President Mike/KE0ESG gave a detailed estimate of the cost for tower crew to install the new coax, antenna, and associated parts (see attachment; the estimate will also be posted to the club website). Nearly \$4,000.00 may be saved by scheduling the tower work with

Great Plains for a date that corresponds with them already working in the area. Discussion on this issue included weather issues, difficulties installing coax and hardware, and the amount of time required to perform the work. Motion by Bob/NOTC, Second by Bob/WBOSXC, to table any vote on whether to "piggyback" the work with another job, or to schedule as a stand-alone job until the next meeting; motion carried.

2. 2020 CDARC Hamfest:

- a. Jeff/K0CMS reported that he had received the gift certificate and catalogs from Ham Radio Outlet.
- b. Doc/KOGRM recommended at the October 2019 meeting that the club purchase an HF rig to be given away at the Hamfest. Jeff/KOCMS brought options for HF rigs to the meeting. After discussion on the options and the cost a motion was made by Doc/KOGRM to purchase a Yaesu FT-891 transceiver, and to rescind the \$100.00 cash prize voted on at the October 2019 meeting to offset the cost of the rig; motion seconded by Randy/KCOCAU; motion carried by a vote of 8 for, and 7 against approving the motion.
- 3. Website/Social Media: Mike/KE0ESG reported that he had posted the draft SOP to the CDARC website for review and comments by the membership. If you have any input, please contact Mike.
- 4. Replacement Vertical Antenna: Mike/KE0ESG reported that the Bismarck State College Club offered to assess the condition of the CDARC Butternut antenna. No expense will be incurred, and the members at the meeting agreed to the assessment.
- 5. CDARC Christmas Party: December 6th, 2019, 6:00 PM, Buffalo Wings & Rings (just south of the north Walmart).

1. Burleigh/Bismarck EOC Call Sign:
Mike/KE0ESG reported that he had received a
