If you are planning on testing for your <u>first</u> Amateur Radio License, go to the following website and obtain a Federal Registration Number (FRN) first, and bring it with you to the testing session:

https://apps.fcc.gov/coresWeb/publicHome.do

(Note: if you already have a license, you already have an FRN; you do not need to register again.)

VOLUNTEER EXAMINERS TAKE NOTE!

All ARRL-accredited Volunteer Examiners (VE's) must participate in at least one testing session every five years for their credentials to remain valid.
