# C. Guests - Artur/KD9QNO, Rick/AG7GJ Committee Reports

1. Technical - Randy/KC0CAU reported on the Hanover Repeater that it had a blown AC fuse. Replaced and repeater now active again. He replaced the memory battery. He reported that it had a high desense on the duplexer. Rich/WB0TML will donate a new 2-meter duplexer to the club.

The equipment for the Burleigh County Emergency Management facility has been delivered. Mike/KE0ESG stated that he did a quick check on the VHF/UHF antenna, and it had a SWR of 1.1 to 1.3 across the band. He will work with Mary Senger, Technical Committee, and Bruce/W0HS to find a date to complete install of equipment.

Mike/KE0ESG showed some pictures of the ice damage at 85 repeater site during April snow/ice storm. No known damage to our equipment currently.

- 2. **Skywarn** Mike/KE0ESG reported that there was 30 people at the Skywarn training in April. Everyone thought the facility was great at the Burleigh County Emergency Management Facility. No additional information on NWS allowing people in facility if activated.
- 3. **VE Testing** Bob/NOTC reported that 1 person tested before meeting and passed Technician test. Also, the manuals and tests for the Technician will be updated on July 1,2022. Anyone studying for the Technician will have until then to take the test.
- 4. **Net Control** Mike/KE0ESG gave report on Net Control on weekly checkins. There are currently 5 Net Controllers and we could use a few more. (see noiseletter for details on check in numbers)
