- 2. **Skywarn:** Mike/KEØESG will contact J.P. Martin on Skywarn Training if it will be held this year. If possible, will try to schedule it at Burleigh County EOC CenCom center. May or may not have a training session due to New Covid / personnel issues.
- 3. **VE Testing:** Bob/NOTC reported that the next testing session will be at Hamfest on Feb. 26<sup>th</sup>. We will not be having any testing at the executive meeting on the second Tuesday anymore. All testing in the future will be on the fourth Tuesday before club meetings at 6pm.

(Note: if you already have a license, you already have a FRN; you do not need to register again)

# **VOLUNTEER EXAMINERS TAKE NOTE!**

All ARRL-accredited Volunteer Examiners (VE's) must participate in at least one testing session every 5 years for their credentials to remain valid.
