Club President Mike/KE0ESG brought the meeting to order at 7:01 pm.

- A. Approval of September 2019 Minutes: Motion by Doc/KOGRM, second by Howard/WBOATB to approve the minutes; motion carried.
- B. Treasurer's Report: Dee/KB0CGK presented the Treasurer's report, and detailed various

expenses since the last meeting. Checking account balance as of October 22nd 2019: \$371.51. Savings account balance as of October 22nd 2019: \$21,229.26. Motion to approve report made by Bob/NOTC, second by Rick/NOMBE; motion carried.

Committee Reports

- 1. Technical: Mark/N0FAZ and Randy/KC0CAU reported that we are on the Great Plains schedule for the repairs needed on the 85 repeater. (NOTE: At the May 2019 CDARC meeting, the members present agreed to the Technical Committee's suggestion to schedule the tower work with Great Plains for a date that corresponds with them already working in the area so that we won't have to pay travel costs. The Executive Committee is now researching funds availability and total cost of the tower work.)
- 2. Skywarn: No report.
- 3. VE Testing: Bob/NOTC reported that one person tested successfully for a Technician license in October.

Old Business

- 1. Old Club Generator: The generator has been paid for and picked up by Lorne/NOCYK.
- 2. CDARC Christmas Party: December 6th, 2019, 6:00 PM, Buffalo Wings & Rings (4424 N 15th St, Bismarck; just south of the north Walmart).

3. 2020 CDARC Hamfest:

- a. Jeff/KOCMS reported on the prizes recommended by the Executive Committee. A motion was made by Mark/NOFAZ, second by Howard/WBOATB, to approve the following prizes at the approximate costs indicated (motion carried): \$100.00 cash prize
 Yaesu FT-8900R Quad Band Transceiver(\$319.00)
 Baofeng UV-82C Dual Band Handheld (\$55.00)
 MFJ 115 24-hour Analog Wall Clock (\$44.00)
- b. Doc/KOGRM recommended that the club purchase an HF rig to be given away as the upcoming event will be the 30th annual Hamfest. Some discussion was held, and this

item was tabled until the November 2019 meeting. Jeff/KOCMS will bring options for HF rigs to the November meeting.

4. Boy Scout Jamboree On The Air (JOTA): Karen/KCOMNE and Rick/NOMBE reported that the JOTA was a great success and thanked the Club for its participation. 53 people attended the event including 30 Scouts. Contacts were made on HF and VHF frequencies, and we listened in on QSO's from several countries. Howard/WBOATB demonstrated CW, which was a big hit with the Scouts.

New Business

- 1. Website/Social Media: Mike/KE0ESG presented a draft document delineating responsibilities for the Club website and social media for discussion. The website has undergone changes and updates in the last month, and improvements have been made to the contact forms. Mike will post the draft document on the website for comment and input; more discussion will be conducted at the November 2019 Club meeting.
- 2. Announcements: Upcoming events (Club Christmas Party and Hamfest) were mentioned.
- 3. Replacement Vertical Antenna: Bob/WB0SXC asked that the Club look into procuring a vertical antenna to replace the Butternut that seems to need some work. Bob has let the Club use his Diamond BB7V portable vertical HF antenna at several events, and it has been very effective. After discussion, it was decided that the Butternut will be evaluated in the spring of 2020 to see if and what kind of repairs are necessary, and then determine if the Club should procure a new vertical antenna.
- 4. Raffle for Repeater Maintenance:
 Bob/WB0SXC suggested that the Club look into
 various avenues to obtain funds to go ahead
 and pay for the travel & per diem costs for a
 tower crew to repair the 85 repeater,
 including some type of raffle. Other
 fundraising avenues were also discussed,
 including grants. The Club has received
 grants in the past for repeater maintenance,
 but in recent years we have not qualified for
 grants due to the specific grant parameters.
 The Club will investigate upcoming grants
 through the local Emergency Management
 agencies.
