- A. Approval of June 2019 Minutes: Motion by Dee/KB0CGK to approve the minutes, second by Howard/WB0ATB; motion carried.
- B. Treasurer's Report: Dee/KB0CGK presented the Treasurer's report, and detailed various expenses since the last meeting. Checking account balance as of July 23rd 2019: \$828.53. Committee Reports

- 1. Technical: Mark/NOFAZ gave an update on the 85 repeater; the old transmission line will be left in place and an Arrow dual band antenna will be connected to it at the break point; this line and antenna will not be put into use unless something happens to the primary line and antenna. The tower crew will contact when they are ready to perform the new transmission line/antenna installation. Mark also reported that he had adjusted another local repeater (440 MHz/6 meter) and brought the new antenna tip for his 200 MHz repeater.
- 2. Skywarn: Zach/K0ZSH sent a report stating that there was one courtesy page in July 2019 to advise of possible severe weather (severe thunderstorm watch), but there were no activations.
- 3. VE Testing: Bob/NOTC reported that one individual was tested this month and successfully passed the Technician test.

The CDARC is taking bids for a generator that is no longer needed.

Generator Specs: Winco Model 305BH FE/I, 115/230 Volt, 3500 Watt, 30/15 Amp, 60 Hz, 8 HP/319 CC Briggs & Stratton 4 cycle motor, age unknown. The generator is currently inoperative.

Only sealed bids will be accepted. The highest bid wins; if two or more identical high bids are received, the bid postmarked or received the earliest wins; in the case of multiple identical bids with the same postmark or receipt, the winner will be determined by a high-card drawing from a deck of cards.

Bids must contain the bidder's name, phone number and/or alternate contact information.

Mail bids to <u>CDARC-Generator Bid</u>, PO Box 7162, Bismarck ND 58507, or bring sealed bid to the September CDARC meeting. Mailed bids must be in the CDARC post office box on or before September 24th, 2019 to be considered responsive.

Hand-delivered sealed bids will be accepted at the September 24th, 2019 CDARC meeting up to the time the proposed generator sale is brought to the floor; no additional bids will be accepted once the bid opening proceeds. If any one party submits multiple bids, the bid with the latest postmark, or which is the latest bid otherwise received by the CDARC, will be considered the official bid.

The successful bidder will have until September 30th, 2019 to pay for the generator (cash or check only) and make arrangements with the CDARC President/Vice President to pick it up.

If no bids are received, the generator will be advertised for sale online.
