July 26TH, 2022 MEETING MINUTES

Club President Mike/KE0ESG brought the meeting to order at 7:04 pm at the Bismarck State College Career Academy.

- A. Approval of June 2022 Minutes: Motion by Lorne/NOCYK-, second by Warren/KFODJJ--- to approve the June 2022 meeting minutes; motion carried.
- B. Treasurer's Report: Dee/KB0CGK gave a detailed update of expenses and income since the last report. The checking account balance as of this meeting is \$953.10; the savings account balance as of this meeting is \$10,840.29. Motion by Mark NOSUU---, second by -Rick/NOMBE to accept the report; motion carried.

Committee Reports

1. Technical: Mark/N0FAZ discussed going to St Anthony (85 Repeater) site to check status of remodel. He also brought up 43 repeater status. Mike/KE0ESG stated that he and

Randy/KC0CAU did a tune up on duplexer. 43 repeater is currently down and needs to be checked. A trip will be planned to check it out

Mike/KE0ESG discussed the HF antenna on the EOC building status. Have been contacted by Electronic Communication on the antenna and they are working on a solution.

2. Skywarn: Mike/KE0ESG reported No activations. Mark/N0FAZ asked if it was strange that we have not been activated yet. Discussion ensued. Bruce/W0HS asked if when activated, will we be using the 85 repeater. The 85 repeater will be the repeater for Skywarn. Mark/N0FAZ suggested we test the pagers on a Friday morning. Mark/N0FAZ stated he will look at an activation of the pagers. Mike/KE0ESG state he would find a manual for the pagers and upload it to the website.

Club President Mike/KE0ESG is looking for someone to take over as the Club Skywarn coordinator. If anyone is interested, please contact him or one of the Club officers.

- 3. VE Testing: Bob/NOTC reported that FCC database has a problem with Apple IOS systems. Use a windows pc to access the database until fixed. The new Technician tests, as of July 1, the new tests are to be used. If anyone took the technician exam before March 2, 1987, they are eligible for the General License. They will not need to test, only complete the paperwork. He also discussed what FCC fees are required for upgrade, address changes, new licenses. Also discussed was the renewal of VE credentials.
- 4. Net Control: Mike/KE0ESG gave report on Net Control on weekly check-ins. There are currently 5 Net Controllers and stated we could use a few more. (See NoiseLetter for details on check in numbers)

Old Business

- 1. Workshops or Projects at BSC: a Dipole antenna project was selected for one of the fall workshops. Also, a demonstration on digital modes is selected for an additional workshop. Mark/NOFAZ suggested a Yagi antenna as another winter workshop. Chad/KCOAFB suggested a G5RV antenna in workshop.
- 2. Field Day Report: Mike/KE0ESG gave a report on how we did on field day. Last year we had 301 SSB voice QSO's with 24 participants and received a score of 852 with bonuses.

This year we had 311 SSB voice QSO's and 109 FT8 digital QSO's for a total score with bonuses of 1,328. This is a good increase from last year.

We did get all 50 states, missed Virgin Islands, Manitoba, and Newfoundland Randy/KCOCAU complied data and submitted it to ARRL

- 3. Club Picnic: August 23rd, 2022, @ 6pm Missouri Slope Model Aero Club facility at the McDowell Dam Recreation Area. Bring your own food, soda and water will be provided. Bob/NOTC will bring VE testing for those who want to test. Mike/KE0ESG will bring his Fox for a hunt.
- 4. Jamboree on the Air. October 15th Setup at 9am at Tom O'leary warming house. Mike/KE0ESG will bring his mobile tower. We should not need to bring trailers to event as we can use a dipole for the event. Equipment will be inside the building for JOTA. Will be there until around 3pm.

New Business

1. Girl Scout Big Event Day: October 1st, 2022. Mike/KE0ESG stated that he was contacted by Nicole Gustafson about participating in the Girl Scout Think Day event on October 1st. We can setup a radio station at Career Academy to demonstrate making contacts with other stations around the country/world. Mike/KE0ESG will create a QSO cards for each event.

Motion to participate in the event by Warren/KF0DJJ seconded by Rich/WB0TML. Motion passed. We will give a short presentation on the value of community service.

- 2. Bruce/WOHS reported that a BX Rohn tower is available for purchase from Bullinger Tree Service. Price is \$300. 7 sections 56 feet tall. Section 1 has some corrosion. If you are planning on testing for your <u>first</u> Amateur Radio License, go to the following website and obtain a Federal Registration Number (FRN) first, and bring it with you to the testing session:

https://apps.fcc.gov/coresWeb/publicHome.do

(Note: if you already have a license, you already have an FRN; you do not need to register again)

VOLUNTEER EXAMINERS TAKE NOTE!

All ARRL-accredited Volunteer Examiners (VE's) must participate in at least one testing session every 5 years for their credentials to remain valid.
